REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

King City Multimodal Transportation Center

Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report

RFP DUE DATE: 12:00 noon on Wednesday, August 5, 2026

The Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) is requesting proposals from qualified and interested consultants or consultant teams to conduct environmental review and complete the appropriate environmental documentation needed to construct a proposed Multimodal Transportation Center (MMTC) to be located along First Street and Pearl Street in King City, CA.

Corrections made to RFP:

This addendum corrects references to the project title in the RFP from *Kings Station* Multimodal Transportation Center and King City Multimodal *Transit* Center respectively, and replaces them with *King City Multimodal Transportation Center*, which is the project title that should be used in consultant proposals and the environmental document to be prepared for the project.

The following are TAMC responses to questions regarding the RFP:

- 1. Does TAMC desire to consider alternative approaches to securing environmental clearance for the King City Multimodal Transportation Center Project?**

TAMC will consider alternatives for conducting environmental review for this project if a firm believes that federal and state environmental requirements can be met, and clearance secured, without completing the full Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report described in the RFP. Interested firms are asked to identify which environmental document and



level of analysis is appropriate for the King City MMTC project and provide justification for its approach, which could be included as an option for conducting environmental review.

2. **On page 8, in section D of the submittal requirements, the RFP states that the references should be provided for all key team members. Is that request meant to be included in the RFP? May we add an appendix for the resumes?**

References for individual key team members are not required and do not have to be included with team member resumes as part of this RFP – Section D on Page 8 is updated to strike-out that specific requirement for references. Resumes can be included as an appendix.

3. **On page 24 of the RFP (within the sample agreement), the verbiage includes "*If TAMC terminates this Agreement for good cause, TAMC may be relieved of the payment of any consideration to Consultant, and TAMC may proceed with the work in any manner, which it deems proper.*" May we please have some clarification on this portion?**

In the event that TAMC chooses to terminate an agreement for good cause as defined earlier in Section 6 (b) of the sample, the contract allows the agency not to pay outstanding invoices to the Consultant and determine the most appropriate approach for completing any remaining tasks and deliverables in the scope of work.
