**4. RECEIVE** presentation on the Pacific Grove Hwy 68 Corridor Study. – Letunic

The Transportation Agency in partnership with the City of Pacific Grove and Caltrans is conducting a study of the State Route68 Corridor in Pacific Grove to identify improvements that will provide safer access for all modes of travel.

**RECEIVE** report on bike share in Monterey – Roveri

Bike share is a transportation program that encourages bicycling as a mode of transportation for short distance trips without having to own a bicycle. On June 21, 2016 the Monterey City Council provided direction to staff to pursue a citywide bike share pilot program.

**6. RECEIVE** report on Ciclovia Salinas. – Murillo/Galarza

Ciclovia Salinas is a youth-driven open streets event that attracts thousands to bike, walk, dance and skateboard along Alisal Street. This year's event will be held on October 9<sup>th</sup>. Event organizers are looking for volunteers to help with the event this year.
