





### Front Street Maintenance Project

### **Project Background**

- The last maintenance project the City of Soledad completed was the 2003 Front Street Revitalization Project in which Front Street between Benito Street and East Street to a variety of improvements to the corridor.
- Since the last project, the corridor has experienced a number of issues with sidewalks, curb and gutter, pavement condition, tree roots causing uplift, an evaluation of the ADA accessibility for access ramps and parking stalls, lighting, and traffic safety.
- The City contracted with Harris & Associates to provide engineering design services for the project.









## Front Street Maintenance Project

### Project Description

Maintenance work along Front Street from the north end at Moranda Road near Hwy 101 south to Nestles Road, consisting of asphalt pavement re-surfacing, repair of existing curb, gutter, sidewalk, tree replacement and landscaping refresh, signing and striping improvements, street lighting upgrades, and art components.

### Project Limits:


Front Street between Moranda Rd and Nestles Rd intersections. Most of the concrete demo and replacement work will be performed on the East Side of Front Street.

#### Project Award:

Contractor: Monterey Peninsula Engineering (MPE)

Estimated Duration: 120 Calendar Days

Estimated Construction Cost: \$3,800,000




### Front Street Maintenance Project

### Current Status

 This project is fully underway, with the construction start date beginning July 29, 2024, and anticipated to be completed with most of the project sometime in late November/early December.

### Project Schedule:

- Tree Removal (7/29 8/8)
- Concrete Work (7/29 8/22)
- Irrigation Retrofit (7/29 8/22)
- Planting (10/22 11/21)
- Retrofit Luminaires (10/1 10/7)
- Traffic Cameras (10/9 11/13)
- New Light Poles and Luminaires (12/26 - 1/31)
- Paving (11/13 11/27)
- Striping/Pavement Markings/Signage (11/27-12/10)



# Cost Share Program for Sidewalk Repair

### Project Background

- The City sets aside \$40,000 every year of the Measure X Funding received to use toward Sidewalk Repair.
- As part of this program, the City shares the cost of 50/50 or up to \$2,000, whichever is less of the two for each project.
- Future Goals are to update Cost Share Program for Sidewalk Repair for current challenges.
