### **Program Purpose & Goal**



• Funds available for non-profit organizations

 Fund non-profit transportation services to support seniors and persons with disabilities Measure X Funding

Regional Road Safety 27% Mobility for all 13%

Seniors & Disabled Transportation \$15M

Local Road Repairs and Safety 60%

Approximately \$500,000 per year

- \$1.5M for:
  - FY 2017/18
  - FY 2018/19
  - FY 2019/20

  - Street crossing skills
  - How to access and safely use

 Focus areas: Castroville, Salinas, Soledad and King City residents


