Christina Watson is the Director of Planning at the Transportation Agency for Monterey County, where she has worked since 2001. Her current responsibilities at the Agency include managing the Monterey County Rail Extension project, acting as the staff legislative liaison on state and federal legislative issues, and supervising a three-person transportation planning team. Christina is active with the WTS San Francisco Chapter as the Monterey Bay Programs chair, for which she was recognized in 2016 as “member of the year”.
